

Upon motion made by Wenande and seconded by Persson, it was moved that the following Ordinance be adopted:

ORDINANCE NO. 331

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2007
APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE #328

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Alexandria, South Dakota, that:

[1] The "2007 APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE #328" be amended as follows:

[a] Moneys shall be transferred from previously budgeted accounts as follows:

1. Fire Department Operating Fund: \$ 818.28;
and
2. Fire Department Reserve Account:
\$ 56,297.45; and
3. Fire Department Mosquito Control
\$ 3,741.90.

[b] Money shall be transferred and added to the following accounts:

1. Water fund: \$ 25,000.00; and
2. Street Improvements Bond Fund: \$32,115.73.
3. Street Department - Mosquito Control:
\$ 3,741.90.

[2] Repealer. Any and all ordinances, or portions of Ordinances, which are in conflict with the provisions hereof, are hereby repealed.

[3] Severability Provision.

Any section, portion, or part of this Ordinance which is determined by any Court to be invalid shall be considered removed there from and the balance of said Ordinance shall remain in effect if the same can be done

for the purpose of carrying out the intent of this Ordinance.

Justification for Ordinance:

- [a] The Fire Department is now its own taxing district;
- [b] The City no longer needs to appropriate moneys to the Fire Department from the City Budget, nor to support the Fire Department through the City budget;
- [c] There are unexpended moneys in the Fire Department Reserve account and operating account which are not needed for 2007 budgeted items; and
- [d] It is in the best interests and welfare of the citizens and residents of the City of Alexandria to appropriate moneys for water tower maintenance and for paying down the City street bond issue and thereby reducing the City's debt load.
