

Upon motion made by _____ and seconded by _____, it was moved that the following Ordinance be adopted:

ORDINANCE NO. 334

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR REGULATION OF THE MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY WITHIN THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, SD

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Alexandria, South Dakota, that:

[1] The city council shall have relation authority over the distribution and use of water within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria; and

[2] The city council may, by resolution, prohibit he sale of water to any persons or parties, when the water is not for use within the city;

[3] All fees and charges for the use and connection to the water delivery system of the city of Alexandria shall be as established from time to time by resolution of the city council.

Justification for Ordinance:

[A] It is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Alexandria that there always be an adequate supply of potable water available for the health and sanitation needs of the residents;

[B] It is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City of Alexandria that the municipal water delivery system accounts remain solvent; and

[C] Adjusting the requirements and operational constraints and restraints relating to the municipal water supply is better conducted by resolution than by ordinance.
