

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE BANKING OF BUILDING WITHIN THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA WITH STRAW, MANURE OR OTHER INFLAMABLE MATERIAL.

ORDINANCE NO. 34

The City Council of the City of Alexandria do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to use for hauling any building within the fire limits of the aforesaid City of Alexandria any straw, manure or other inflammable materials.
- Sec. 2. That any person violating the provisions of this act shall on conviction thereof, be fined a sum not exceeding \$5.00 for each and every offense and the costs of prosecution.
- Sec. 3. It shall be the duty of the City Marshall to notify each and every person violating the provisions of the above act to remove the same at once, and in case of refusal to do so, the Marshall is instructed to bring such offender before the Police Justice for trial.
- Sec. 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force from and after its approval and publication.
