

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT BOYS FROM CLIMBING ON ENGINES OR RAILROAD
CARS UNDER PENALTY OF FINE OR IMPRISONMENT

ORDINANCE NO. 35

The City Council of the City of Alexandria do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons under the age of 21 years, to climb upon engines or railroad cars while switching within the City limits of the said City of Alexandria.
- Sec. 2. Any violation of the above provision shall be punishable by a fine of not exceeding \$10.00 or under \$5.00, or imprisonment in the County Jail not to exceed thirty days nor less than 10 days, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.
- Sec. 3. It shall be the duty of the City Marshall to arrest any and all persons known by him to be violating the provisions of the above section, or upon the complaint of any citizen, and bring him or them forthwith before the Police Justice or City Mayor for Trial.

This Ordinance shall go into effect immediately after its passage and approval.
