

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE KEEPING OF TIPPLING SHOPS AND PROVIDING
A PUNISHMENT THEREFOR

ORDINANCE NO. 36 ½

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. That any person who, within the limits of this city shall keep or maintain a tippling shop to be used as a beverage, or sell any intoxicating liquors in any such tippling shop or place, shall upon conviction be fined in any sum not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars, and in addition thereto may be imprisoned not to exceed thirty days.
- Sec. 2. This shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
