

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES BY PROHIBITING THE RIDING OF BICYCLES ON ANY OF THE SIDEWALKS OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA AND THE PLAYING OF BALL ON MAIN STREET OF SAID CITY

ORDINANCE NO. 39

The City Council of the City of Alexandria do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to ride any bicycle or tricycle on any of the sidewalks within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria.
- Sec. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to practice throwing ball, playing catch or playing ball in any manner, on Main Street of said City of Alexandria.
- Sec. 3. Any person or persons violating the provisions of Section 1 and 2 of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Police Justice or any Justice of the Peace, shall be fined in a sum of not less than one dollar nor more than five dollars for each and every offense.
- Sec. 4. It shall be the duty of the City Marshall to arrest any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance and bring him or her before the proper officer for trial.
- Sec. 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed.
- Sec. 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval and publication.
