

GRANTING TO ALEXANDRIA SEWAGE COMPANY, A CORPORATION, ITS SUCCESSORS, AND ASSIGNS, THE RIGHT TO USE THE STREETS AND ALLEYS AND PUBLIC GROUNDS OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A SEWER SYSTEM.

ORDINANCE NO. 48

The City Council of the City of Alexandria do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1. That in consideration of the benefits to be derived by the inhabitants of the City of Alexandria, by the construction and maintenance of a sewer system in the said City, the said Alexandria Sewage Company, a Corporation, its successors and assigns, are hereby granted the right to use the streets and alleys and public grounds of the City of Alexandria, South Dakota, for the construction and maintenance of a sewer system for the ten of twenty years from the date of the adoption or approval of this Ordinance.
- Sec. 2. That for such purposes the said Alexandria Sewage Company, its successors or assigns, may enter upon any of the streets, alleys or public grounds of the said City of Alexandria and dig its ditches and lay its tile and do such other work as may be necessary for the proper establishment and maintenance of such sewer system.
- Sec. 3. That the privileges herein granted are given under the following conditions to-wit: that the said Alexandria Sewage Company, its successors and assigns, shall within six months after the passage and approval of this Ordinance have laid at least four blocks in length of sewage which shall connect with the main sewer which shall connect with the main sewer of the City of Alexandria, South Dakota, at some convenient place east of the stock yards as now located and be ready for use.
- Sec. 4. In case any property owner adjacent to where such sewer is built desires to connect to said sewer he shall have the privilege of doing so upon buying one share of the unsold corporate stock at not to exceed \$100.00.
- Sec. 5. The expense of publishing this Ordinance shall be paid by the Alexandria Sewage Company.
- Sec. 6. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
