

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF THE CITY OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, S.D.

ORDINANCE NO. 51 ½

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, S.D.:

That as full compensation for the discharge of the duties of their respective officers as the same are and may be defined by law, or any Ordinances of said City now or hereafter in force, the following named officers shall be paid as follows:

Each Alderman shall receive the sum of \$100.00 per annum.

The City Treasurer shall receive the sum of \$30.00 per annum.

The City Auditor shall receive the sum of \$25.00 per annum.

The Police Justice shall receive such fees as are now and may hereafter be provided by law.

The City Justice of the Peace shall receive such fees as are now or may hereafter be provided by law.

The City Assessor shall receive such an amount per diem as is now provided for a township assessor.

The City Attorney shall receive the sum of \$1.00 per annum and in addition thereto, such further sums as may in the opinion of the City Council be adequate compensation for the work performed however, in no case to exceed the sum of \$200.00 per annum.
