

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE CROSSING OF STONE, BRICK, CEMENT OR
WOOD CROSSINGS WITH TRACTION ENGINES OR BUILDINGS

ORDINANCE NO. 52 ½

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

That it shall be unlawful for any person, persons or corporations to cross any stone, brick, cement or wood street crossing, or walks across the street with a traction engine or building, without first having placed upon or across said street crossing or walks, plank not less than three inches in thickness.

Any person, persons or corporation failing to observe the provisions of this Ordinance shall be liable jointly and severally to a fine of not less than ten nor more than twenty five dollars from each and every offense.
