

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A CITY PLUMBER AND
FOR TAPPING OF CITY WATER MAINS AND SEWER

ORDINANCE NO. 53

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. That there shall be appointed by the Mayor by and with the approval of the City Council, a City Plumber for the City of Alexandria.
- Sec. 2. Duties and compensation—That the duties of the said City Plumber shall be to look after the City water main and City Sewer of the City of Alexandria, and receive as compensation therefore such fees as are ordinarily charged by a City Plumber for the same kind of work, to be paid by the person having said work done.
- Sec. 3. That it shall be unlawful for any person, persons or corporations to tap the city water main or city sewers of the City of Alexandria and except only the City Plumber who shall keep in a book kept for that purpose a complete record in feet and inches the plan of tapping said main and sewer.

Any person, persons or corporations violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be liable to a fine of not less than ten nor more than twenty five dollars for each and every offense.
