

AN ORDINANCE REGULATION POOL AND BILLIARD AND BOWLING ALLEYS IN
THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, SOUTH DAKOTA

ORDINANCE NO. 55

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, S.D.:

- Sec. 1. No person or persons owning or having charge or control of any billiard or pool table or the room or other place where such tables are kept for hire, or the room in which any bowling alley is maintained for hire, shall knowingly permit or refuse any person under the age of 18 years to remain in such room or place which shall be under his control, and in case any such person neglects or refuses to depart immediately upon request, the owner, keeper, or other person in charge shall forthwith make complaint to the City Marshall of such neglect or refusal, whose duty it shall be to remove such person.
- Sec. 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00 and stand convicted until such fine is paid and such conviction shall work a forfeiture of his or their license.
- Sec. 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
