

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND LICENSE THE USE OF DRAYS, OMNIBUSES,
CARRIAGES OR OTHER VEHICLES, AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION
THEREOF

ORDINANCE NO. 56

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. That no person as owner, agent or employee, shall keep or drive any dray, cart, wagon, or any other vehicle for the purpose of transporting for hire any goods, merchandise, or property from one place to another in said City, without first paying to the City Treasurer a license fee of \$10.00 for each year.
- Sec. 2. That no person as owner, agent, or employee shall keep or own any omnibus, carriage or other vehicle for the purpose of carrying passengers for hire in said City without first paying to the City a license fee of \$10.00 per each year.
- Sec. 3. That any person who shall violate this Ordinance or any part thereof, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$20.00 for each and every offense and stand committed to the City Jail until such fine is paid.
