

AN ORDINANCE CONSOLIDATING THE FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD WARDS OF  
THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, SOUTH DAKOTA FOR VOTING PURPOSES.

ORDINANCE NO. 58

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, S.D.:

- Sec. 1. Where as the number of legal voters in the first, second and third wards of the City of Alexandria, South Dakota, does not exceed two hundred and fifty as determined by the last annual election, it is therefore ordained by the City Council of the said City of Alexandria that the first, second and third wards of the said City of Alexandria be consolidated into one precinct for voting purposes as provided by Section 1285 of the Revised political code of 1903 of the State of South Dakota as amended by Chapter 19 of the Session Laws of the State of South Dakota for the year 1913.
- Sec. 2. The alderman to be elected from each of said wards shall be nominated and elected by the qualified voters residing therein, and the voters residing in one ward shall not vote for alderman to be elected from hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval and publication.

Read for the first time Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1914 and read for the second time and passed this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March 1914 and approved this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March 1914.
