

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND LICENSE BOWLING ALLEY, PIN ALLEYS, AND BALL ALLEYS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA

ORDINANCE NO. 60

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons whomsoever to run or cause to run any bowling alleys, pin alley having first ordained from the City a license so to do.
- Sec. 2. Such license shall be \$25.00 per annum, payable in advance, or \$15.00 for six months payable in advance or \$5.00 per month, payable in advance for each and every bowling alley, pin alley, or ball alley.
- Sec. 3. Any person violating the provisions of the above sections shall be fined in a sum not less than \$25.00 or more than \$100.00 for each and every offence.
