

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEEDING MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA

ORDINANCE NO. 62

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. That it shall be unlawful for any owner or person having in charge any motor vehicle, as defined in Chapter 276 of the Session Laws of 1913, to operate such motor vehicle on the streets or public highways within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria at a greater rate of speed than one mile in four minutes.
- Sec. 2. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) or by imprisonment in the County Jail of Hanson County, South Dakota, for not exceeding ten days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- Sec. 3. Ordinance No. 57 and all Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
