

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE ERECTION OR USE OF TILE, TERRA CATTIA,
CEMENT BLOCK, BRICK ON EDGE OF METAL FLUES

ORDINANCE NO. 65

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria as follows:

- Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to erect or use in or on any building within the corporate limits any tile, terra cotta, hollow cement blocks, brick on edge of metal chimney.
- Sec. 2. It shall be unlawful to erect or maintain or have in use any chimney, smoke stack or other structure for the escape of smoke, heat or gases in such condition as to endanger property.
- Sec. 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the conditions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offense. Each and every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.
- Sec. 4. It shall be the duty of the Chief of Fire Department or other duly authorized person to make systematic inspection at least once every three month and make report to the City Council, or any violation of any of the terms of this Ordinance.
- Sec. 5. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with the foregoing are hereby repealed.
