

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE STORAGE AND HANDLING OF CRUDE OIL,
GASOLINE, BENZINE, BENZOLE, NAPHTHA, AND OTHER LIGHT PRODUCTS OF
PETROLEUM

ORDINANCE NO. 66

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria as follows:

- Sec. 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to keep or store, or cause to keep or stored more than ten (10) gallons of gasoline, benzine, benzole, naphtha, or other light or volatile products of petroleum, or crude petroleum, in or within 20 feet of any building or buildings, within the fire limits of the City of Alexandria, South Dakota, except that said oils, and their products mentioned above may be kept in underground tanks or in a separate building built for such purpose according to the specifications of the fire limits Ordinance, not less than 20 feet from any other building within the fire limits.
- Sec. 2. It shall be unlawful for the oils, and their products above mentioned, it above ground, to be stored or kept or sold in other than closed metallic cans painted red to signify the inflammable nature of the contents thereof.
- Sec. 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating this Ordinance shall be fined in a sum of not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and costs.
- Sec. 4. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with the foregoing are hereby repealed.
