

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PROTECTION FROM ELECTRICAL HAZARDS BY
REGULATION OF THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF ALL DEVICES AND
EQUIPMENT FOR THE GENERATION, TRANSMISSION AND UTILIZATION OF
ELECTRICAL CURRENT

ORDINANCE NO. 67

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria as follows:

- Sec. 1. That the National Electrical Code is hereby adopted as the standard for all electrical installations, and no installation of electrical equipment shall be made, except in conformity thereto, within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria.
- Sec. 2. Any person, firm or corporation, and the agents or servants of any person, firm or corporation violating this Ordinance shall upon conviction, be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offense. Each ten days of maintenance prohibited conditions constituting a separate offense.
- Sec. 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflict with the foregoing are hereby repealed.
