

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING COASTING AND THE RIDING OF VEHICLES WHEN SELF PROPELLED UPON THE PUBLIC SIDEWALKS IN THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA

ORDINANCE NO. 69

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. No person while riding upon any sled, wagon, or other vehicle shall coast upon or along any public sidewalk or any street in the City of Alexandria.
- Sec. 2. The word "coast" as used in Section 1 hereof shall mean to aide, glide or move by the force of gravity or momentum.
- Sec. 3. No person shall ride on any sled, wagon or other vehicle upon or along any public sidewalk of any street in the City of Alexandria who shall propel, or furnish the motive power for the sled, wagon or other vehicle upon which he shall be riding.
- Sec. 4. Any person violating the provisions of Section 1 or Section 3 of this Ordinance shall be fined in a sum of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$25.00 for each offense.
