

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT THE PLAYING OF BALL, THROWING OF
SNOWBALLS, OR OTHER AMUSEMENT OR PRACTICES HAVING A TENDENCY TO
ANNOY PERSONS PASSING IN THE STREET OR ON THE SIDEWALKS

ORDINANCE NO. 71

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria as follows:

- Sec. 1. No person shall in any street, alley or sidewalk play ball or throw or toss a ball.
- Sec. 2. No person shall on any street, alley or sidewalk, throw any snowball or engage in any other amusement or practices having a tendency to annoy persons passing in the street or on the sidewalk.
- Sec. 3. Any person violating the provisions of Section 1 or Section 2 of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof pay a fine of not less than one dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).
- Sec. 4. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
