

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO G. H. MONTGOMERY AND C. H. STILLWELL, THEIR SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, THE RIGHT TO ERECT, INSTALL AND MAINTAIN SIXTEEN ORNAMENTAL STREET LIGHTS POSTS ON MAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA

ORDINANCE NO. 72

The City Council of the City of Alexandria, do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1. That the right is hereby granted to G. H. Montgomery and C. H. Stillwell, their successors and assigns to place, construct, install and maintain for a period of twenty years on Main Street in said City between Third Street and Sixth Street sixteen ornamental street lighting posts, complete and all necessary underground cables, and junction boxes.
- Sec. 2. Said ornamental street lighting posts, underground cables and junction boxes, shall be installed and erected under the direction of the City Council at such points and places on said Main Street as shall be designated by said City Council.
- Sec. 3. In consideration of the foregoing and of the annual payment to said G. H. Montgomery and C. H. Stillwell, their successors and assigns by the said City of Alexandria, of an amount equal to 10 per cent of the total installed cost of said sixteen ornamental street lighting posts underground cables and junction boxes for street electric lighting purposes, the same to be connected with the city electric light plant, provided that all connections shall be made by and at the expense of the City.
- Sec. 4. Upon the installation of said sixteen ornamental street lighting posts underground cables and junction boxes, the said G. H. Montgomery and C. H. Stillwell, their successors and assigns, shall file with the City Auditor of the City of Alexandria, a verified itemized statement of the total installed cost of said sixteen ornamental street lighting posts, underground cables and upon payment to said G. H. Montgomery and C. H. Stillwell, their successors and assigns, of the actual installed costs thereof to purchase the same from said G. H. Montgomery and C. H. Stillwell, their successors and assigns, and upon payments of said amount to said G. H. Montgomery and C. H. Stillwell, their successors and assigns, granted by the times of this Ordinance, shall cease.
- Sec. 5. The said City of Alexandria in addition to the payment hereinbefore mentioned for the use of said ornamental street lighting posts, shall pay all necessary up-keep expense incident thereto while in use by said City.
