

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING MONEY FOR WELL PURPOSES

ORDINANCE NO. 74

Whereas, a petition has been presented to the City Council signed by a majority of the legal voters of the City of Alexandria paying the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be appropriated for the purpose of digging or drilling an additional well for municipal and domestic purposes, and furnishing equipment therefore;

Therefore, the City Council of the City of Alexandria do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1. There is hereby levied upon the taxable property of the City of Alexandria for the year 1915 the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) to be used for digging or drilling an additional well and providing equipment therefore, to provide water for municipal and domestic purposes.
- Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated for the purposes above named the specified sum of money when received to be paid into the waterworks fund.
- Sec. 3. Said levy of taxes hereinbefore made shall be included in and made a part of the regular annual levy of tax to be made by the City Council of the City of Alexandria in September 1915, and shall be certified by the City Auditor of the City of Alexandria to the County Auditor of Hanson County, South Dakota for extension of the taxes on list of said County, under and pursuant to the laws of the State of South Dakota.

Read for the first time the 5th day of May 1915.

Read for the second time and passed this 12th day of May 1915.
