

AN ORDINANCE IN RELATIVE TO A SUPPLY OF LADDERS, FOR FIRE PURPOSES

ORDINANCE NO. 8

- Sec. 1. It is hereby ordained by the Board of Trustees, of the Town of Alexandria, Territory of Dakota, that every owner of a building on Main Street, between Eighth Street and Railroad Street, shall supply and keep a ladder long enough to reach the roof of said building, and such ladder shall be kept on the premises, and shall not be removed from said premises except in case of fire. Any person offending against any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not exceeding ten dollars and costs of prosecution.
- Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force in thirty days after the passage of this Ordinance.
