

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUE OF COUPONS BONDS FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PURPOSES

ORDINANCE NO. 9

- Sec. 1. It is hereby ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Alexandria, County of Hanson, Territory of Dakota, that as five-eighths of the citizens owners of the taxable property of the Town of Alexandria, have petitioned the Board to bond said Town in the sum of Three Thousand Dollars for draining, grading, and putting in cross walks on Main Street, from the middle of the street, between Sixth and Seventh Streets, to Railroad Street, thence draining into Pierre Creek, the Board hereby ordered the issuance of bonds in the sum aforesaid, by virtue of the powers granted the Board, in Chapter 24, Sec. 27, or the Revised Code of the Territory of Dakota, relative to Corporate Indebtedness.
- Sec. 2. The Bonds shall be issued in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, each, with Coupons annexed, bearing eight per cent interest, payable annually, and run ten years. The sum, principal, and interest, shall be payable at the Office of the Treasurer of the Town of Alexandria, and the bonds shall bear date January 2nd, A.D. 1884, and shall not be sold at less than par, with the accrued interest, and the Board reserve the right to redeem the bonds at par, in five years from the date thereon.
- Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 21st day of December 1883.
