

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ERECTION AND MAINTENANCE OF
BILLBOARDS, SIGNS, AND ADVERTISING MATTER WITHIN THE CITY OF
ALEXANDRIA, SOUTH DAKOTA

ORDINANCE NO. 92

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, or persons to mail, paste, paint or otherwise affix in any manner whatever any lithograph sign, advertisement, picture or design whatever or to erect or maintain any billboard within the City of Alexandria, Hanson County, South Dakota, without first obtaining a permit so to do from the City Council of the City of Alexandria and the matter of granting such permit, shall be within the discretion of the City Council, provided, however, that this Ordinance shall not apply to lithographs, signs, advertisements, pictures or designs on the inside of any building within said City of Alexandria.
- Sec. 2. Penalty. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each offense.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
