

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING AND PROHIBITING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF HORSES, CATTLE, SWINE, IN THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, SOUTH DAKOTA

ORDINANCE NO. 97

Be it ordained by the City of Alexandria, South Dakota:

- Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, company, or corporation to permit or to suffer any horses, cattle, swine, sheep, goats, or poultry to run at large within the City of Alexandria, South Dakota.
- Sec. 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof pay a fine of not less than five dollars or more than ten dollars.
- Sec. 3. Any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
