ARTICLE XXVI

BUILDINGS AND USES AFFECTED

SECTION 1. MINIMUM BUILDING REQUIREMENTS: No building or structure shall be erected, enlarged, reconstructed, or moved into the zoning jurisdiction with less than the following:

1. Dwelling Units:

 All dwelling units shall provide a minimum floor area, exclusive of porches, breezeways, and garages, as follows:

TYPE OF DWELLING UNIT	MINIMUM AREA
Single-Family	600 square feet
Two-Family	600 square feet per unit
Multiple-Family	480 square feet per unit

- Every dwelling unit shall be provided with at least one (1) water closet, which water closet shall be located within the dwelling and in a room which affords privacy.
- Every dwelling unit shall contain a kitchen sink which is connected to running water and an approved sewer system.
- Every dwelling unit shall be enclosed with an exterior wall surface, other than tar paper or corrugated galvanized metal.
- No basement or cellar shall be occupied for residential purposes until the main portion, aboveground, is completed.

2. Bed and Breakfast Inns:

 All units shall be served with an approved public water supply and an approved public sanitary sewer system.

3. Motels:

a. The number of motel units permitted on a tract of land shall not exceed the number obtained by dividing the total square feet of area of the site by one thousand five hundred (1,500). Commented [GT3]: Corrugated metal was replaced with galvanized metal 10/05/2020
