

CITY OF OXFORD, KANSAS

ORDINANCE NO. 340

(Published in the Wellington Daily News on Wednesday, September 15, 2021)

An ordinance regulating public offenses and traffic offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Oxford, Kansas; incorporating by reference the 2021 Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities and the 2021 Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities.

Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Oxford:

Section 1. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE.

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Oxford, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the “Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, 48th Edition” prepared by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas.

Section 2. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE.

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Oxford, Kansas, certain code known as the “Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities, 37th Edition” prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas.

Section 3. MAINTAINING COPIES.

A copy of this ordinance shall be attached to the 48th Edition of the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities and the 37th Edition of the Public Uniform Offense Code for Kansas Cities, and no fewer than three copies of the aforementioned Code and Ordinance shall be marked “Official copy as adopted by Ordinance No. 340” and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable times.

Section 4. Ordinance number 326, which adopted the 2019 edition of these codes, is hereby repealed.

Section 5. PRIORITY OF LAW.


The terms of the Code of the City of Oxford and in particular, Chapter XI, Public Offenses, and Chapter XIV, Traffic, shall control over the terms of the uniform laws adopted above. All references within Chapter XI and Chapter XIV to the specific year edition of either the Standard Traffic Ordinance or the Uniform Public Offense Code are hereby replaced by the 2021 editions herein adopted.

Section 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, and after its publication in the official city newspaper, as provided by law.



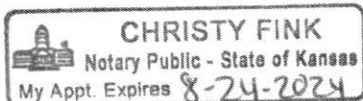
