ORDINANCE NO. 341

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 304, RELATING TO HOURS OF RETAIL SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR, AND CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 215 RELATING TO THE RETAIL SALE OF ENHANCE CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES WITHIN THE CITY OF OXFORD, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OXFORD, KANSAS:

Section 1. Article 3 of Chapter III of the Code of the City of Oxford, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 3-304 HOURS OF SALE. No person shall sell at retail in the original packaging any alcoholic liquor:
 - (a) On Sunday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day, before 9:00 a.m. or after 8:00 p.m.
 - (b) On Easter Sunday, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day
 - (c) Before 9:00 a.m. or after 11:00 p.m. on any day when the sale thereof is permitted.

Section 2. Section 3-304 as it existed prior to this ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Article 2 of Chapter III of the Code of the City of Oxford, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3-215 BUSINESS REGULATIONS.

(c) Except as provided by subsection (d), no enhanced cereal malt beverages may be sold or dispensed; (1) Between the ours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m.; (2) in the original package before 9:00 a.m. or after 8:00 p.m. on Sunday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day; (3) on Easter Sunday; or (4) for consumption on the licensed premises on Sunday, except in a place of business which licensed to sell enhanced cereal malt beverage for consumption on the premises, which derives not less than 30% of its gross receipts from the sale of food for consumption on the licensed premises.

Section 4. Section 3-215(c) as it existed prior to this ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be published one time in the official city newspaper.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after September _____, 2021.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF

OXFORD, KANSAS: Section 1. Article 3 of Chapter III of the Code of the City of Ox-

ford, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3-304 HOURS OF SALE. No person shall sell at retail in the original packaging any alcoholic liquor:

(a) On Sunday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day, before 9:00 a.m. or after 8:00 p.m.

(b) On Easter Sunday, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day

(c) Before 9:00 a.m. or after 11:00 p.m. on any day when the sale thereof is permitted.

Section 2. Section 3-304 as it existed prior to this ordinance is

hereby repealed.

Section 3. Article 2 of Chapter III of the Code of the City of Oxford, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3-215 BUSINESS REGULATIONS.

(c) Except as provided by subsection (d), no enhanced cereal malt beverages may be sold or dispensed; (1) Between the ours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m.; (2) in the original package before 9:00 a.m. or after 8:00 p.m. on Sunday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day; (3) on Easter Sunday, or (4) for consumption on the licensed premises on Sunday, except in a place of business which licensed to sell enhanced cereal malt beverage for consumption on the premises, which derives not less than 30% of its gross receipts from the sale of food for consumption on the licensed premises.

Section 4. Section 3-215(c) as it existed prior to this ordinance is

hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be published one time in the official
