



Intermediate Quilt

Want to expand your quilting skills? If you've been sewing for a while, consider yourself a confident beginner, or have made a few quilt projects and want to know more, come join me. This class will expand on the beginner quilting class, but it is not a pre-requisite to this class. I will show you curved piecing, foundation paper piecing, mitered borders, and more.

Supply List:

Thread (60wt) (I recommend Quilter's Select)
Rotary Cutter (45mm)
Pins
Quilting Ruler (at least 6" x 24")
¼ inch foot for your sewing machine
Walking foot for sewing machine
Quilting 75/11 Needles
Thread Snips
Seam Ripper
Sewing Machine w/ Bobbins, power cord and foot pedal
Notebook
Seat cushion
Pen or pencil
Beverage with lid
Lunch or snack (microwave and refrigerator available)

Sew Standard seam guide
Mister Bottle with magic
Wonder clips
Extension Table
Fork Pins
Stitch in the Ditch Foot
12 ½ inch square ruler
