Backing: 1yd Binding: 1/4yd

Cutting List to Make Two Four-Block Rotation, which will make the 12" center and four corners.

Fabric - No. of Pieces - Size to Cut

White - **16** - 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles (1 - 5 1/2" strip WOF)

White - 16 - 3 1/2" x 7" rectangles (1 - 7" strip WOF and 1 - 3 1/2" strip WOF)

Yellow - 8 - 2 1/2" x 7" rectangles (1 - 7" strip WOF)

Lt Blue speck - 8 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles (1 - 6 1/2" strip WOF)

Dk Blue grunge - 8 - 2 1/2" x 8" rectangles (1 - 8" strip WOF)

Green - 4 - 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles (1 - 12 1/2" strip WOF)

1st border - 4 - 1 1/2" by WOF

2nd border - 4 - 2 1/2" by WOF

3rd border - 4 - 1 1/2" by WOF
