

Basic Sewing Supplies

- Sewing machine with power cord and pedal
- $1 / 4$ " foot or " J " foot (for BabyLock/Brother)
- "N" foot or Open Toe Foot
- Thread snips, fabric scissors, paper scissors

Fabrics

- $11 / 8$ yard dark blue fabric (includes binding)
- $2 / 3$ yard medium blue fabric
- $11 / 8$ yard background fabric
- $11 / 2$ yard backing fabric
- 27" X 54" batting


## "Storm on the Lake"

This table runner features a classic block, "Storm at Sea," using the Creative Grids Square on Square Trim Tool. You will love how accurate the results are with this great tool. You'll do some easy paper piecing for one block to get great points.

## Notions

- Pattern: Cut Loose Press "Storm on the Lake" (included in class fee)
- Creative Grids "Square on Square 6 inch Trim Tool" (included in class fee)
- Foundation paper for paper piecing (included in class fee; block pre-printed. You don't need to trace!)
- 6" or 12" "Add-a-Quarter" Ruler
- Rotary cutter ( 45 mm ) and ruler (such as Creative Grids $61 / 2 \prime \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ )
- Sewing thread to match background fabric
(see page $\mathbf{2}$ for preparation prior to class. Please allow enough time to do your cutting prior to class)


## Preparation \& Cutting Prior to Class

- Press your fabrics prior to cutting. Best Press does a great job at helping get out the folds and creases.
- Dark Blue Fabric
- Cut (3) 7" WOF strips; sub-cut into (27) 4" X 7" rectangles for the paper pieced diamonds
- Cut (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ X WOF strip for the centers of the $6^{\prime \prime}$ units; sub-cut into (10) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
- Cut (1) 2" X WOF strip; sub-cut into (18) 2" squares for the centers of the $3^{\prime \prime}$ units
- Cut (4) $2 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ X WOF strips for binding
- Medium Blue Fabric
- Cut (3) $3^{\prime \prime}$ X WOF strips for the $3^{\prime \prime}$ units ( $\mathrm{A} / 2$ ); sub-cut into (36) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut once on each diagonal. Label "A/2"
- Cut (3) $41 / 2$ " X WOF strips for the 6 " units ( $B / 2$ ); sub-cut into (20) $41 / 2 \prime$ squares. Cut once on the diagonal. Label " $\mathrm{B} / 2$ "
- Background Fabric
- Cut (3) $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ X WOF strips for the $3^{\prime \prime}$ units (A/1); sub-cut into (36) $21 / 2 \prime$ squares. Cut once on the diagonal. Label "A/1."
- Cut (2) $31 / 2 \prime$ " X WOF strips for the $6^{\prime \prime}$ units ( $B / 1$ ); sub-cut into (20) $31 / 2 \prime$ squares. Cut once on the diagonal. Label "B/1."
- Cut (5) $4 \frac{112 \prime \prime}{2 \prime}$ X WOF strips for the paper-pieced diamonds; sub-cut into (54) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 \prime$ rectangles. Separate into two groups of 27 rectangles.

It is helpful if you label your pieces and either put them in baggies or clip them.
