Pants – Simplicity #8022



In the pants class, you'll learn all the skills needed to make a great pair of fun play or pajama pants.

You will learn how to choose and prepare the correct size pattern, cut out your fabric and mark all the pieces.

Then learn how to sew straight and curved seams, insert elastic, and make a clean hem.

Wear your fun new pants all summer long!

Supply List:

- 1. **Pattern**: Simplicity #8022
- 2. **Fabric**: Woven cotton: suggested solid color or non-directional print enough yardage for your size. **Prewashed before class***
- 3. Matching thread
- 4. **Elastic**: 1 inch wide non-roll elastic
- 5. **Ribbon or Cord**: ¼ inch wide

Tools:

- 1. Fabric shears
- 2. Paper scissors (for cutting out the pattern)
- 3. Small scissors or thread snips
- 4. Fabric measuring tape
- 5. Straight pins
- 6. Fabric marking pen or pencils
- 7. 6-inch seam gauge
- 8. Seam ripper
- 9. Large safety pin

*Due to fabric shrinkage, excess dye, & starch applied during manufacture, it's essential that the fabric is washed and dried before coming to class. Fabrics can shrink up to 25%, sizing, or starch, can change the hand of the fabric considerably. Launder the fabric in the same way you plan to launder the finished garment. Be careful to wash with similar colors in case the dye bleeds!
