Gored Skirt

Intermediate / Butterick #6179



A gored skirt is great for all seasons! This 8-gore skirt has a smooth fit at the waist and flares out to a flirty hemline that flows beautifully when you walk.

Learn how to install a centered zipper, work on your top-stitching skills, and attach a stable waistband. You'll also learn some tricks for hemming a curved edge.

You'll come away with some new skills, and a flattering skirt that you can make again in lots of different fabrics!

Supply List:

- 1. Pattern: Butterick #6179
- 2. Fabric: Light to medium weight woven like medium to heavy Rayon, Challis, Lightweight Twill or lightweight denim, medium weight Linen. Prewashed before class*
- 3. Interfacing: Lightweight Fusible
- 4. Zipper: 12 inch standard zipper
- 5. Pant hook
- 6. Matching thread

Tools:

- 1. Fabric shears
- 2. Paper scissors (for cutting out the pattern)
- 3. Small scissors or thread snips
- 4. Fabric measuring tape
- 5. Straight pins
- 6. Fabric marking pen or pencils
- 7. 6-inch seam gauge
- 8. Seam ripper
- 9. Pinking shears
- 10. Hand sewing needles
- 11. Thimble

^{*}Launder the fabric in the same way you plan to launder the finished garment. Be careful to wash with similar colors in case the dye bleeds!
