Beginner

In the second class of the serger series, you build on the skills learned in Serger 101. Or if you are already familiar with your serger, this class will give you more in-depth knowledge.

We cover how stitch length and width change your seams, how to secure ends, and we'll review thread tension. Learn flatlocking for seams that look like ready-to-wear and how to do rolled hems for fine fabrics and gorgeous table linens.

This class includes a kit with pre-cut fabrics and binder pages to keep your samples for future reference.

MACHINE:

- Serger
- Manual
- Accessories

SUPPLIES:

- Thread: red, green, blue, and yellow - 1 of each
- Double-sided tape
- Fray Check or other seam sealant
- Loop turner
- Darning needle
- Fabric shears
- Thread snips
- Straight pins
- Seam ripper
- 6" seam gauge
- Fabric: Although a pre-cut fabric kit is provided, you may want to bring some woven cotton fabric scraps for additional practice. Light solid colors only (no prints or darks).

NOTE: Thread can be cones or standard spools.
Make sure you have all four colors!
