

Twister Christmas Tree

Thank you for signing up for the Christmas Tree quilt using the little twister that I will be teaching.

Please try to get the pre-work completed before class to ensure that you can finish piecing the quilt during class time.

My tree was made using a single fabric for the tree, it can be more graphic if you choose several fabrics, all can be different shades of green or you can add a pop of color in to look like ornaments.

Attached you will find a photo of some twister trees I found doing a google search and my pattern/instructions for the tree.



Supply List:

- ☐ Fabric for Tree: For 3 colors, 1/3 yard for each shade of green
- ☐ Backing Fabric: 11/2 yard
- ☐ Background Fabric (White or color of choice) 11/4 yard
- ☐ Star (topper): 5" Square
- ☐ Batting
- ☐ 'Lil Twister ruler for use with 5" squares
- ☐ Sewing machine in good working condition (recently cleaned and oiled)
- ☐ 1/4" foot, walking foot (optional)
- ☐ Coordinating thread
- ☐ Needles (80/12 universal or sharp).
- ☐ Typical sewing supplies you typically bring to class/retreat including but not limited to scissors, rotary cutter, mat and ruler, straight pins, wonder clips
