

Costa Maya Supply List

Costa Maya is a great quilt to really showcase some of your beautiful **large scale** fabrics. We will surround two of your large scale fabrics with 3 blender fabrics in a simple court house step construction. We will have fun in class with prize drawings throughout to keep you going, and lots of gorgeous blocks to show off. Here's the details:

Quilt Size

The quilt finishes 72" x 72".

Yardage

You will need **two LARGE SCALE focus fabrics** to make up the triangle sections of the quilt (BUT REMEMBER, we make them out of the easy peasy courthouse step block!), 1-3/4 yd of one large scale print and 1-1/4 yd of the other large scale print.

Next you will need **three blender** fabrics that coordinate with your focus fabrics. These fabrics should have contrast and grade from dark, to medium, to light. For the dark, you need 1 yard, the medium fabric you will need 1-1/4 yd, and for the light, you will need 2 yards. Boom! Done! Wasn't that easy?!!

Rulers

It is helpful to have a 6"x18" and at least a 10" square ruler at different times during the construction of this quilt. I'll bring mine to share if any one doesn't have access to these rulers, and perhaps others will share.

Other

Other than the above, you will only need customary sewing supplies, needles, thread, seam ripper, snips/scissors, small ruler, sewing machine in good working order with a quarter inch foot or guide, and any chocolate or snacks you need to keep you going ☺ Cutting mats, ironing boards and irons are in each classroom, supplied by the Quilt Festival.
