

Not Your Grandmother's Dresden

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Pattern (Required): "Double Wide Dresden" by Me and My Sister Designs

Materials & Supplies (60" x 60" Quilt):

Dresden Wedges	Ten (10) Fat Quarters*
Background	4 yards
Backing	4 yards
Binding	1/2 yard

*If you wish to use smaller cuts of fabric from your stash, you'll need fourteen (14) 4-1/2" x 40" strips (cut from width of fabric).

- Sewing Machine (including power cord, pedal & instruction book)
- Extra Sewing Machine Needles
- Thread (for piecing & for edge-stitching/machine applique')
- Rotary cutting equipment (rotary cutter, mat, ruler)
- Template Plastic or Double Wide Dresden Ruler
- Straight Pins
- Water-Soluble Fabric Glue (Optional)
- Point Turner
- Thread snips/scissors/seam ripper
- Marking pen/pencil/mechanical pencil

(Note: I will have patterns and the Double Wide Dresden Rulers available for purchase at the class.)

Pre-Class Preparations/Cutting Instructions

Please have the following pieces cut prior to coming to class. Bring these cut pieces and all additional fabric to class, too.

From each Fat Quarter:

- Cut three (3) 4-1/2" x 21" strips.

From the Background Fabric:

- Cut eight (8) 15-1/2" strips.
- Sub-cut these 15-1/2" strips into a total of sixteen (16) 15-1/2" x 15-1/2" squares.
