

Collage Quilt Class

Choose one of the mini / wall hanging patterns by Laura Heine/Fiberworks with finished dimensions under 50 inches. We can help you pre-order any of Laura's patterns.

In the first class session we will be planning your project, not yet starting to work. Chrissy will talk through the various options for creating a scrappy, "arty" background for your collage and help you make sure you have all your supplies based on your plan.

Session 1 is a planning session. Bring note paper and pencil. You do not need machine and sewing supplies.

Supplies for Sessions 2&3

Fabric for quilt top

- **Low volume/light colored fabric**
 - Scraps or fat 1/8ths for background, enough to make your quilt's background
- **Brights and fussy cutting print fabrics**
 - Scraps or fat 1/8ths for applique
- **Binding**
 - ½ yard if using one fabric or create from scraps used in your project (Chrissy will show her technique for creating a scrappy binding)

Other Quilt Supplies

- **Steam a Seam Lite 2**
 - 1 yard (more if your applique piece is larger)
- **Backing fabric**
 - A few inches bigger than your quilt's finished dimensions.
- **Batting**
 - A few inches bigger than your quilt's finished dimensions.

Basic sewing supplies

- **Sewing Machine**
 - in good operating condition, with a ¼" foot or able to adjust needle position to ¼" and a quilting or walking foot. Bring your machine's other feet, as well, to try different stitches to embellish your project.
 - Don't forget your foot pedal and power cord
- **Ruler** just need a straight edge
- **Rotary** mat and cutter
- **Thread** 100% cotton (not hand quilting), neutral color for piecing and color of your choice for quilting
- **seam ripper**

- **straight pins**
- **Basic sewing supplies**
- **scissors** (serrated are great for applique)
- **a pencil**

Reminders from Intown Quilters

- When you come on the day of the class we ask that you park behind the shop. As you enter the parking lot there is a slope between our shop and the alterations shop, just drive down there and you will find parking. This will make unloading your supplies easier since you will be entering the classroom! If there is not parking behind our shop or the alterations shop, please unload your car and then park in the mall parking lot. Thank you!
