

PURPLE MOUNTAIN MAJESTY

BLOCK 12

unfinished 12 1/2" Block

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Background fabric:

Sixteen - 2 1/2" squares

Two - 5" squares

Marble fabric:


Eight - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

One - 4 1/2" square


Two - 5" squares

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:


Place a background 5" square and a marble 5" square on top of each other with right sides together. Then draw a line diagonally across square. Stitch 1/4 inch on each side of line, then cut on solid line. Once opened you will have two half square triangles, trim down to a 4 1/2" squares. You will have four - 4 1/2" squares.



To make the flying geese block take all sixteen 2 1/2" background squares and draw a line diagonally on the back. Then place one 2 1/2" square on one each side of the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" marble rectangle as shown, sew on line, trim off extra and press open. Repeat with other side to make 8 flying geese blocks. Sew 2 together to make a unit. Make 4 units.



Place block together using diagram below.



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Setting fabric requirements

Background - 3 yards

Grey Mountains - 1 1/4 yards

Outer Border - 1 7/8 yards

Binding - 3/4 yard


Backing - 6 yards of regular width fabric or

2 5/8 yards of wide backing

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Center of Quilt

Place your 12 blocks together in any order you would like. Three blocks across by four blocks down. Your quilt center will measure 36 1/2" x 48 1/2".



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BORDERS

PIECED BORDER CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Marble Fabric


3 - 8 3/8" strips WOF - sub-cut into 8 3/8" squares, 14 squares

Background fabric


3 - 8 3/8" strips WOF - sub-cut into 8 3/8" squares, 14 squares

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:


Place a background 8 3/8" background square and a marble 8 3/8" square on top of each other with right sides together. Then draw a line diagonally across square. Stitch 1/4 inch on each side of line, then cut on solid line. Once opened you will have two half square triangles. Make 14 sets, you will have a total of 28 half square triangles.



Next cut half of your 8" blocks into 2" sections with the triangles turned like in example 1 and the other half as shown in example 2





Re-sew the 2" strips from each half square triangle in reverse order as shown below.




Purple Mountain Majesty

Border continued


Sew 3 of each sets together as shown below. Make two sets, these are your top and bottom borders.



Do the same for your side borders, but sew 4 of each set together as shown below.




INNER BORDER (background fabric): cut five 5" strips WOF. Cut two of the strips 36 1/2" for the top and bottom border. Cut one strip in half and sew to the other two full strips, then cut those two strips to a 48 1/2" length. Sew your top delectable mountain border to your inner border strip. Do the same thing for your bottom border and your side borders.




Make Half Square triangles from the 2 - 13" background squares and the 2 - 13" marble squares using same technique on previous page. Then trim them to 4 - 12 1/2" squares.

On the top and bottom borders add a 12 1/2" half square triangle block to each end.

Sew the side borders on first, then add your top and bottom borders.



Sew Borders on as shown, quilt will measure 60 1/2" x 72 1/2"



3rd Border (background fabric)-

Cut 8 strips 5" WOF - sewing two together to make two that are 60 1/2" x 72 1/2" for the side borders and two that are 60 1/2" for the top and bottom. Add side borders first, then top and bottom borders.

Outer Border -

Cut 8 strips 8" WOF - sewing two strips together to make two that are 8" x 81 1/2" for side borders and two that are 8" x 84 1/2" to make the top and bottom borders.

Add side borders first then top and bottom borders. 84 1/2" x 96 1/2"
