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BLOCK TWO

Cutting Directions

Background fabric:

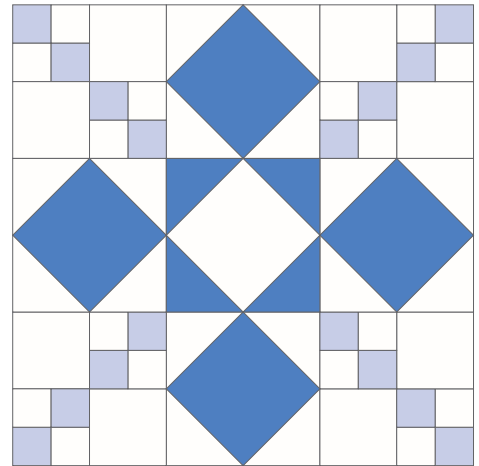
- 1 – 4½" square
- 24 – 2½" squares
- 16 – 1½" squares

Light print fabric:

- 16 – 1½" squares

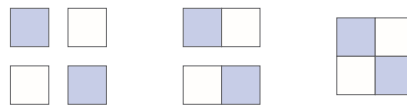
Medium print fabric:

- 4 – 4½" squares
- 4 – 2½" squares

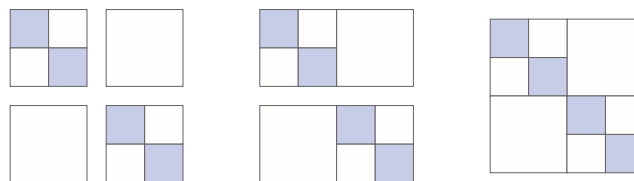


Sewing Directions

Arrange 2 – 1½" background squares and 2 – 1½" light print squares in a 4-patch formation as shown. Sew the squares together in 2 rows. Press the seams of each row towards the print squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press 1 direction. Square to 2½" if needed. Make 8 – 4-patch units.



Arrange 2 – 4-patch units and 2 – 2½" background squares in a 4-patch formation as shown. Sew the units together in 2 rows. Press the seams of each row towards the background squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press 1 direction. Square to 4½" if needed. Make 4 corner units.



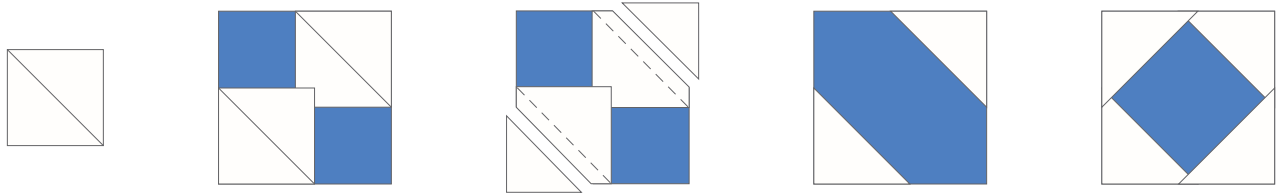
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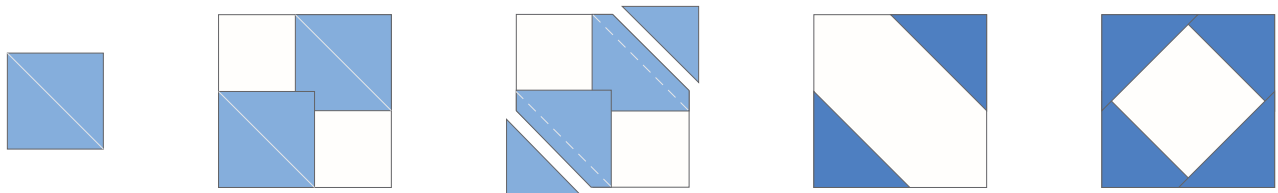


BLOCK TWO – Page 2

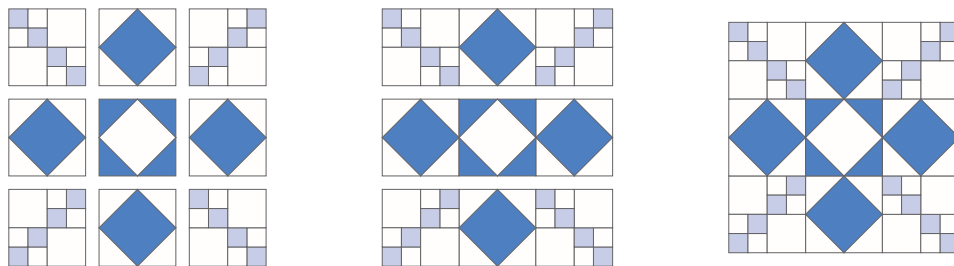
Draw or press a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of each remaining $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background square. Lay two marked $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares, right sides facing, on 2 opposite corners of a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " medium print square as shown. Sew on the marked lines. Trim the excess fabric away $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the sewn seams. Press open towards the corners. Repeat to snowball the remaining corners using another 2 marked $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares. Square to $4\frac{1}{2}$ " if needed. Make 4 outer squares.



Draw or press a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of each $2\frac{1}{2}$ " medium print square. In the same manner as above, snowball the 4 corners of the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " background square. Square to $4\frac{1}{2}$ " if needed. Make 1 center square.



Arrange the 4 corner units, 4 outer squares, and center square in a 9-patch formation as shown. Sew the units together in 3 rows. Press the seams towards the outer squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press to complete Block Two.
