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BLOCK TEN

Cutting Directions

Background fabric:

4 – 2½" x 4½" rectangles

4 – 2½" squares

16 – 1½" squares

Light print fabric:

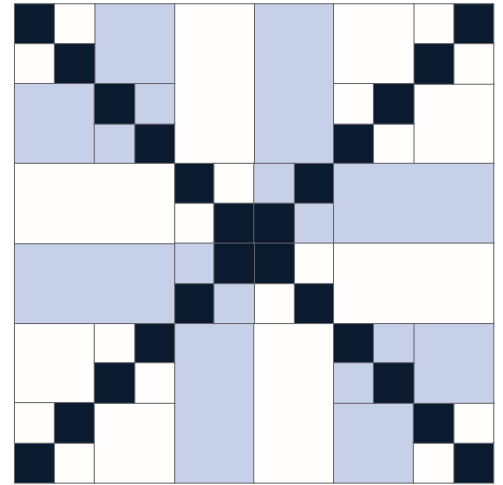
4 – 2½" x 4½" rectangles

4 – 2½" squares

8 – 1½" squares

Dark print fabric:

24 – 1½" squares



Sewing Directions

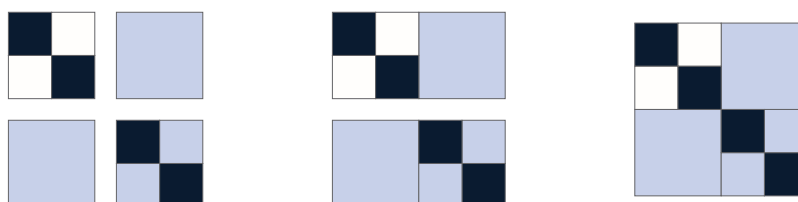
Arrange 2 – 1½" background squares and 2 – 1½" dark print squares in a 4-patch formation as shown. Sew the 4-patch together in rows. Press towards the print squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together to complete a 4-patch. Repeat with 15 – 1½" background squares and 15 – 1½" dark print squares to make 8 background 4-patches.



Repeat the previous directions using the 8 – 1½" light print squares and 8 remaining 1½" dark print squares to make 4 light 4-patches.



Arrange 1 background 4-patch, 1 light 4-patch, and 2 – 2½" light print squares in a 4-patch formation as shown. Sew the unit together in rows and press each row towards the 2½" squares. Nest the seams and sew the unit together. Press. Make 2 units.



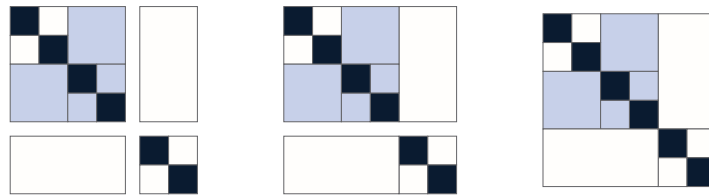
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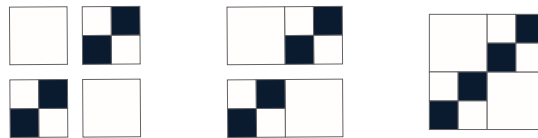


BLOCK TEN – Page 2

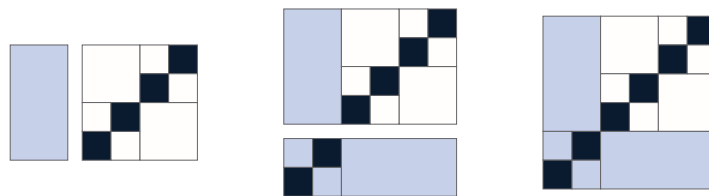
Arrange 1 unit just made, a background 4-patch, and 2 – $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangles as shown. Sew the quadrant together in rows and press towards the background rectangles. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press. Repeat to make a second quadrant A.



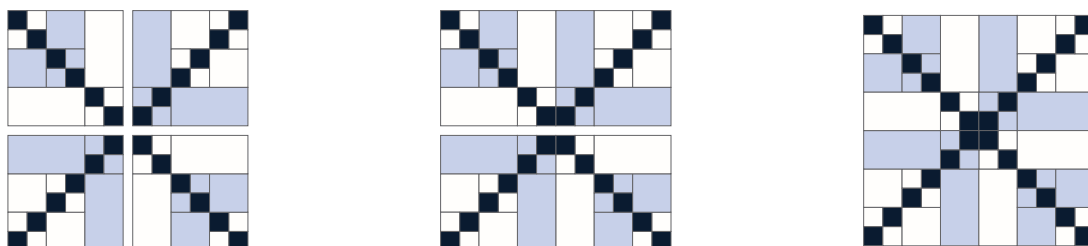
In the same manner as before, arrange and sew 2 – $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares and 2 background 4-patches as shown. Make 2 background units.



Arrange 1 background unit, a light 4-patch, and 2 – $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " light print rectangles as shown. Sew the unit together in rows and press towards the rectangles. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press. Repeat to make a second quadrant B.



Arrange the 4 quadrants as shown. Notice that each row has a quadrant A and a quadrant B. Sew the quadrants together in rows. Press the top row towards the right and the bottom row towards the left. Nest the seams and sew the rows together to complete Block Ten.



BLOCK TEN SIZE: $12\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished
