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BLOCK SEVEN

Cutting Directions

Background fabric:

4 – 2" x 9½" rectangles

4 – 2" x 6½" rectangles

2 – 3½" squares

1 – 1½" square

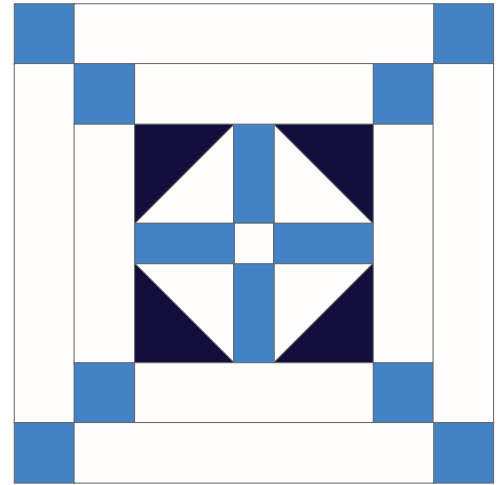
Medium print fabric:

8 – 2" squares

4 – 1½" x 3" rectangles

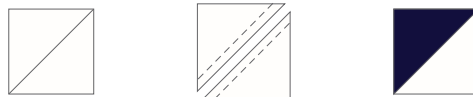
Dark print fabric:

2 – 3½" squares



Sewing Directions

Draw or press a diagonal line from corner to corner on each 3½" background square. Lay a marked 3½" background square on top of a 3½" dark print square, right sides together. Sew a ¼" seam allowance on either side of the diagonal line. Cut along the diagonal line to make 2 half-square triangles. Open and press toward the print fabric. Trim each half-square triangle to 3". Repeat with another marked 3½" background square and 3½" dark print square. You will have 4 background/dark half-square triangles.



Arrange 4 background/dark half-square triangles, 4 – 1½" x 3" medium rectangles, and 1 – 1½" background square as shown. Sew the units together in 3 rows. Press the seams towards the background rectangles. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press 1 direction. Square to 6½" if needed. Make 1 center unit.



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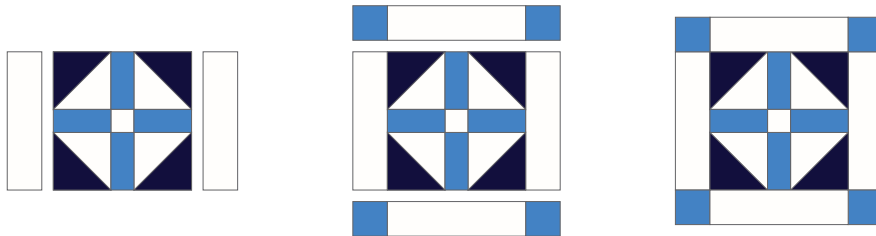


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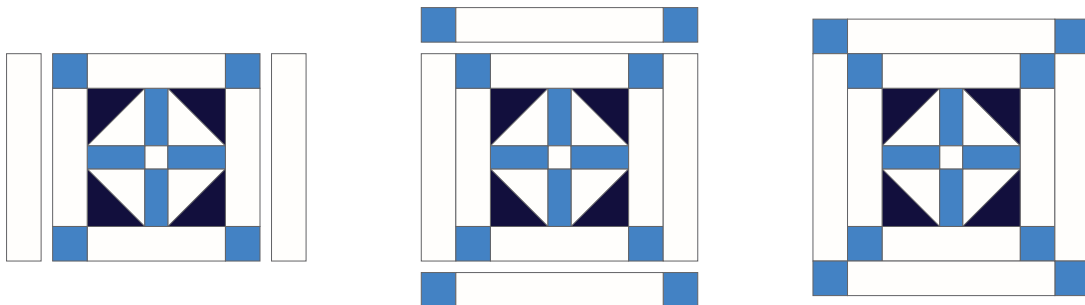
Sew a 2" medium print square to either end of a 2" x 6½" background rectangle. Press towards the squares. Make 2 short units. In the same manner, sew a 2" x 9½" background rectangle. Make 2 long units.



Sew a 2" x 6½" background rectangle to either side of the center unit. Press towards the center unit. Sew a short unit to the top and bottom of the center unit and background rectangles. Press towards the short units.



In the same manner, sew a 2" x 9½" background rectangle to either side of the unit just made. Press towards the center unit. Sew a long unit to the top and bottom of the sewn unit. Press towards the long units to complete Block Seven.
