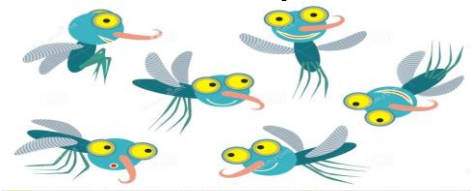


MOSQUITO SPRAYING SCHEDULE
