TREE TRIMMING ORDINANCE

This is a reminder for all residents and businesses in
Peabody that it is your responsibility to trim your
trees at least 16ft above streets, 8ft above sidewalks
and driveways in accordance with Article 4 of the
Code of the City of Peabody.

We ask that everyone take a few minutes to observe
your trees and trim them if need be for the safety of
all vehicles and pedestrians alike.

*****Fall Cleanup Oct 20th*****

Furniture, appliances and trash bags are not allowed to be placed at the curb (except for Spring and Fall Cleanup weeks). Waste Connections will only pick up items placed in the trash and recycle poly carts. Items for the Fall curbside cleanup can be placed at the curb beginning Sunday, Oct 14th. **Waste Connections will provide regular trash collection and recycle on Friday, Oct 19th.** They will make one pass through town on **Saturday, Oct 20th for curbside cleanup.** Please make sure all items are bagged, boxed, or bundled for easy pick up and placed at the curb by Friday evening, Oct 19th.

Household Hazardous Waste - Mobile Collection Unit will be at First & Vine on Saturday, Oct 20th from **noon to 2pm** for hazardous material drop off.
