# "Final Whistle" 

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## Fabric 'B': All sizes:

-Cut 4 strips $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ width of fabric (WOF). Trim 2 strips to $61 / 2 " \times 411 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (inner side borders) and 2 strips to $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (inner top and bottom borders).
-Cut 6 strips 3" x WOF. Sew together into one long strip, using diagonal seams. Sub cut into 2 strips 3 " x 60 " (side borders) and 2 strips $3 " \times 48 "$ (top and bottom borders).
-Cut 3 strips $43 / 4$ " x WOF. Sub cut into 4 pieces $43 / 4$ " x 9 " (corners). Cut 4 squares $43 / 4$ " x $43 / 4$ " (side additions). Cut 28 pieces $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times 43 / 4 "$.
-Cut 6 strips 13/4" x WOF. Sub cut into 128 squares $13 / 4$ " x 13/4". On the wrong side of all the squares, draw a pencil line diagonally from corner to corner.


Sew 10 snowball blocks together with the $11 / 4$ " $\times 43 / 4$ " ' $B$ ' pieces between as shown below. These are the side border pieces. Add a $43 / 4$ " Fabric 'B' square to each end of the row. Make 2. Trim to $511 / 2$ " long. Sew to the sides of the quilt center. The image of the quilt on the front cover is a computer generated quilt (the actual fabric was not available at time of printing). The side "pucks" are closer to the top and bottom than what is shown in the image. The extra Fabric ' $B$ ' background is there to allow for differences in actual seam allowances because there are so many seams in the border, some quilters may need this extra fabric to trim the borders to the correct length.


Sew the $11 / 4 " \times 43 / 4 "$ ' $B$ ' pieces between 6 snowball blocks. Sew a $43 / 4 " \times 9$ " 'B' rectangle to each end of the row. Make 2. Trim to $43 "$ long. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center.


There are 3 corrections made to the pattern - all are in red above.
