
Pinwheel Block of the Month – June Block

"Clay's Choice"

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Fabric 'A' 4" x 14½"	Fabric 'B' 41/4" x 81/4"	Fabric 'C' 4¼" x 8¼"	Fabric 'D' 4 ¹ / ₄ " x 8 ¹ / ₄ "	Fabric 'E' 4 ¹ / ₄ " x 22 ¹ / ₂ "

Cutting Directions:


Fabric 'A': Cut four 3½" squares.

Fabric 'B', 'C' & 'D': Cut two 3\%" squares. On the wrong side of the 'B' squares, draw a pencil line diagonally across each square. These are your cutting lines. On both sides of the cutting line, draw a pencil line a scant 1/4". These are your sewing lines. Fabric 'E': Cut four 3½" squares. Plus cut two 3½" squares. On the wrong side, draw a pencil line diagonally across each square. These are your cutting lines. On both sides of the cutting line, draw a pencil line a scant 1/4". These are your sewing lines.


General Directions: Use 1/4" seams throughout. It is best to use a 1/4" foot on your machine. Use a dry iron (no steam).

Assembly directions:


1) -Take a 31/8" 'B' square and put it on top of a 31/8" 'D' square. Sew along drawn sewing lines. Cut along drawn cutting lines. Repeat until there are 4 of these 2-coloured squares. Sew into the centre pinwheel square. Square to 6½".



2) -Place a 31/8" 'E' square on top of a 31/8" 'C' square. Sew along drawn sewing lines. Cut along drawn cutting lines. Repeat until there are 4 of these 2-coloured squares. Sew a 3½" square to the right side.



3) -Sew middle, top and bottom rows:



Assemble block.
