

**Fabric 'C':**

**Both sizes:** Cut 2 strips 8½" x wof. Cut into the following pieces: 8½" x 20½" (upper right pieced border), 8½" x 16½" (right top pieced border), 8½" x 12" (lower left pieced border) and 7 rectangles 8½" x 2½" (Star blocks).

-Cut 1 strip 5¼" x wof. Cut into 8 squares 5¼" x 5¼". Use the remnant from above cut, if needed. For Zig-zags.

-Cut 2 strips 2⅞" x wof. Cut into 32 squares 2⅞" x 2⅞". Draw a pencil line diagonally on back of squares. Also use the remnant from the first cut. For Zig-zags.

**Fabric 'F':**

**Both sizes:** Cut 1 strip 5¼" x wof. Cut into 8 squares 5¼" x 5¼". This is a tight cut. For Zig-zags.

-Cut 1 strip 3" x wof. Cut 2 squares 3" x 3" and 1 square 2½" x 2½". On the wrong side of the 2½" square, draw a pencil line diagonally from corner to corner. Trim the remaining strip down to 2⅞" and add to the next step.

-Cut 2 strips 2⅞" x wof (add strip from above). Cut into 32 squares 2⅞" x 2⅞". Draw a pencil line diagonally on back of squares. For Zig-zags.

**Making the Zig-zags:**

1) Make the Flying Geese units "4 at a time" by placing Fabric 'C' 2⅞" squares on opposite corners of Fabric 'F' 5¼" squares. The drawn lines should make one continuous line. Sew a scant ¼" on both sides of the drawn lines. Cut on the drawn line. Press towards Fabric 'C'. Place Fabric 'C' 2⅞" square on the remaining corner. Sew a scant ¼" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press towards Fabric 'C'. This will make 4 Flying Geese units with Fabric 'F' as the larger triangle piece. Trim to 2 ½" x 4 ½". Repeat, making 32 (you will use 30).

9) Place a Fabric 'C' 3" square on top of a Fabric 'F' 3" square. Sew a scant ¼" on both sides of the drawn lines. Cut on the drawn line. Press towards Fabric 'F'. Square to 2½". Make 4. Sew together into 1 4½" block.
