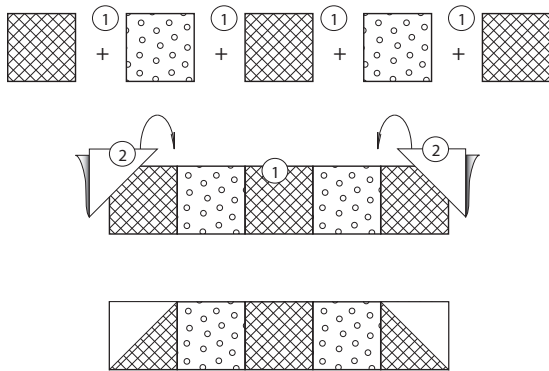


May Mystery Quilt Along

Clue 4: Large Base Unit: Make 4. ($2\frac{1}{2}" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$)

	Fabrics	May Mystery Clue 4
	Teal (dark green, aqua, teal)	12 - $2\frac{1}{2}"$ squares
	Green (medium green, kelly, grass)	8 - $2\frac{1}{2}"$ squares
	Background	8 - $2\frac{1}{2}"$ squares, 8 folded



1. **Large Base Unit:** Sew the following $2\frac{1}{2}"$ squares together alternately to make a strip unit as shown. 3 teal, 2 green. Press to the green squares.
2. Place a background $2\frac{1}{2}"$ folded triangle on the top left and right corners of this unit and adhere with a dab of glue.
3. **Mystery Section B:** Sew a large top unit to the top of a large base unit. Seams may be twisted or pressed open. Make 4.

Mystery Section B: Make 4. ($6\frac{1}{2}" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$)
