Clue 5: Accent Squares: Make 12. ( $\left.61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$

|  | Purple <br> (dark accent) | 12-11/2" squares |
|  | Background | 12-51/2" squares <br> 24-11/2" x 51⁄2" strips |



1. Sew a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ purple accent square to the end of a $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$ background strip. Press to the strip.
2. Sew a $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2} \times 51^{\prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$ background strip to a $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background square. Press to the strip.
3. Sew the two rows together to make an accent square. Press to the strip. Make 12.

Mystery Section C: Make 4. (12½" $\left.\times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$

4. Mystery Section C: Sew together three Accent squares and a nine-patch block from clue 1.
5. Sew the squares together in rows, then join rows to complete mystery section $C$. Press to the large background squares. Make 4.
